This will be used to update the marriage or civil union registration.

How to apply

To deposit a divorce or dissolution certificate issued outside New Zealand, you must provide an original dissolution certificate. This certificate will be kept by Births, Deaths and Marriages.

If the certificate is not written in English, you need to provide an English translation from an approved organisation. To find a translation service, you can:

- Check the New Zealand Yellow pages under Interpreters and Translators at www.yellow.co.nz
